This release note describes the system corrections (as reported by Customers) and new enhancements, if any, made in BASSnet BI Dashboard 1.3 carried out in the Hotfix 1-000 patch released on 24th April 2024.

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
Front-End Enhancements

This section lists enhancements to the front-end user interface and general features in the system.

1. [CR 15214] New Discussion Feature

BASSnet BI Dashboard now allows users to interact with other users, make comments, and provide feedback directly on reports via the new Discussion feature. The **Discussions** pane will be displayed on the right when users click the Discussion icon on any of the BI reports available.


The user who is the thread starter/owner must enter the title and comment when initiating a new discussion.



The thread starter must then select any one of the following three user categories to share the discussion with:


- **Private:** Select this option if your comment is meant to be a private note or a draft that you do not intend to share with anyone.
- Internal: Select this option to share your comment with users having BI Dashboard access right but no External BI Dashboard access right.
- **Specific users:** Select this option to share your comment with only selected users having BI Dashboard rights.





When posting comments in a discussion thread, users have the option to edit or delete their own comment by hovering over the comment. Users can also like comments posted by other users.

On the other hand, thread starters can choose to resolve a discussion if necessary, edit the original comment, delete the entire discussion, and manage sharing of the discussion (select a different user category to share with). These options can be selected by clicking the vertical ellipses icon.



The following User Matrix shows which user can / cannot view and comment on discussions based on the sharing category for six different scenarios, assuming there is one Admin user, three Internal users, and three External users.





2. [CR 15253] New External Report View Domain for Admin and Internal users

The newly added **External Report View** in the domain panel is useful when an Admin or Internal user wants to start a discussion with External users who can only view the Default Report.

It provides direct access to the Default Report specifically configured for External users so that Admin and Internal users can engage with selected External users to provide feedback, discuss on issues, and make comments directly on the report via the **Discussions** feature.






3. [CR 15254] Increased Security via Single Sign-On (SSO)

BASSnet BI Dashboard now supports Single Sign-On login using Azure Active Directory (AAD). This allows users to log into BI Dashboard using their company-assigned login credentials. The implementation of SSO increases the level of security it can provide in gaining access to the system and reduces password fatigue.

To enable this feature, the system configuration 'SecSingleSignOnAuth' must be enabled in **BASSnet Configuration Utilities** by changing its Key Value to 2.




When the configuration is enabled, the **Company Login** button will be displayed on the Login screen.





Note: Ensure that the user is associated with the Azure Active Directory account by entering the relevant **Active Directory ID** on the **BASSnet – User** screen.





BI Report Enhancements

The following enhancements have been made to BI Reports in version 1.3 HF1, as described below.

1. World Map Upgrade

- ☐ [CR 15244] The following reports that include the World Map will now display **Emission Control Areas** (ECA) in green and **High-Risk Areas** (HRA) in red.
 - Fleet World Map
 - Vessel Latest Status
 - Work Rest Hours Analysis
 - Accident & Incident Analysis


In addition, vessel points on the Fleet World Map will now be displayed as arrows A that indicate the direction in which they are travelling.





2. Procurement

☐ [CR 15243] The **Procurement Efficiency KPI** and **Procure to Pay Average Days** reports have been enhanced by adding a new **Weekends** filter for users to select whether to include or exclude weekends when calculating the number of days. By default, the filter is set to exclude weekends.




3. Human Resource


- ☐ [CR 15242] The **Crew Demographics Overview** report has been updated with several new elements to enhance data presentation for crew planning and management. Listed below are some of the changes implemented in the **Crew Overview** and **Detail** tabs:
 - Introduced a new Average Longevity KPI.
 - Introduced a new Seniority vs. Longevity graph to allow comparison of crew composition between their average seniority holding a ranked position and average duration employed, to inform strategic human resource management and planning decisions.
 - Updated the Age Distribution graph to include breakdown by Gender.
 - Repositioned KPIs at the top to align with the natural reading flow, from top to bottom, ensuring immediate visibility of key metrics.
 - Remodelled the Age & Seniority Matrix by updating the data points based on the Stored Procedure, where previously the age and seniority of crew members were calculated differently.
 - Updated the Crew Nationality table to a graph to show the distribution by gender for each nationality along with the crew count.
 - Updated the Seniority graph to show crew count by average seniority and by rank type. This graph also includes the drill-down capability to show the average seniority by multiple sub-ranks under the main rank type.



- Added a new Manning Agent category to the Total Crew Onboard graph so users can see the total number of crew members by their manning agents.
- Removed filters that are not relevant to the Crew Demographics Overview.



- Updated the hardcoded crew URLs on the Crew Details page to dynamic URLs with the capability to change based on the users' environment.
- Updated the Crew Details table to include the new Longevity column so that crew longevity data can be viewed and compared with the crew seniority data when users drill through the details.





BI Data Warehouse Enhancements

This section lists enhancements made to the BI Dashboard Data Warehouse.

■ New Tables and Data Elements in BI Dashboard

Since v1.3, many new Tables and Data Elements have been added to the system to allow users to extract a larger variety of data into their BI Reports.

The following table displays the updates by domain in BI Dashboard from versions 1.3 to 1.3HF1:

BID 1.3HF1

With the addition of new ETL, tables, and data elements to support the updated Crewing report, there has been an increase in data elements compared to BID 1.3. The increase is also attributed by an update in Procurement and Commons data elements. Logic changes have also been made in the Stored Procedure related to Safety and Quality.
