### Changes


#### 1. Fleet Management

- ☐ [82297] Resolved the slow performance when saving newly created components on the **Component Group Setup** screen and also when connecting equipment to component on the **Vessel Component Setup, (Main) Component, and Sub Component** screens.

#### 2. Maintenance

- ☐ [82471] Resolved an issue on the **Defects** screen where users could not set a **Due Date** for new defects if not granted the **Maintenance Defects - Edit Due Date** access right.

By right, users should be able to set the Due Date when creating a new defect even if not granted the access right as it only applies to existing defect Due Dates.






### 3. Material

- ❑ [82438] Resolved an issue where active and inactive materials were not clearly distinguished in the **Location Manager**.

Even though users can still update inactive materials if required, a new '**Inactive**' column has been added under the **Materials** tab to improve organization and management. With this new column, inactive materials are filtered out by default, and users must clear filters on any column to view both active and inactive material records.



The '**Inactive**' column on the **Inventory** screen has also been updated to function similarly (as explained above).



#### 4. Procurement


- ❑ [83226] Resolved an issue on the **Purchase Order** screen where the **Journal Entry Date** was not updated after using the **All Received** button to perform goods received when the 'POJEDCONFIGURABLE' configuration was enabled.
- ❑ [83223] Enhanced system performance to reduce the probability of encountering an issue where items disappeared from Requisition or Purchase Order records after sending Email to supplier.

#### 5. Projects

- ❑ [83122] Resolved an issue on the **Manage Projects** screen where the sorting of a column in the **Sections** or **Jobs** tab for one project incorrectly carried over to another project (by clicking **Find** and selecting another project).
