

## BASSnet 2.11 SP3 Hotfix 8-000 Patch Release Notes

### This release addresses the following issues:

This release note describes the new enhancements and system corrections (as reported by Customers), if any, made in BASSnet 2.11 SP3 carried out in the Hotfix 8-000 patch released on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2025.

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## Enhancements (CRs)

### 1. Home & Administration

- ❑ [CR 16008] BASSnet now supports multi-domain login using Single Sign-On (SSO), allowing users to alternate between different domain accounts within the same organization.

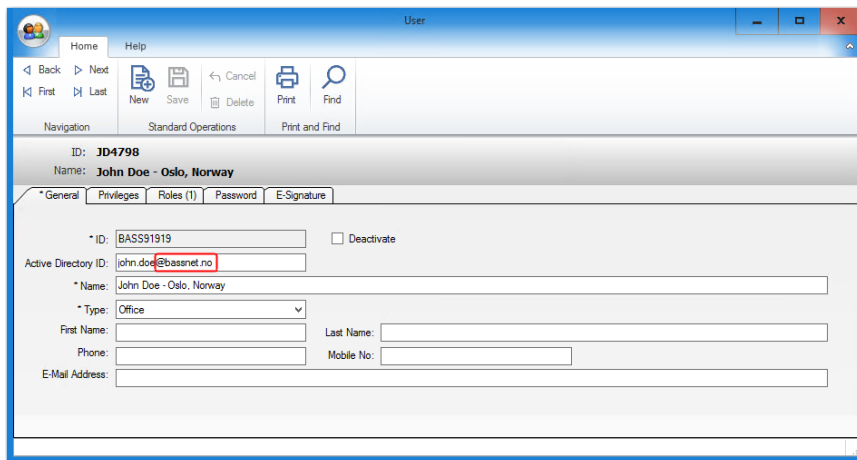
For customers using SSO via Azure Active Directory (AAD), please ensure that the Active Directory ID is entered in the format **user@domain.com** to ensure successful authentication.

For example, a user John Doe who has accounts in Norway and Malaysia with two domains must log in with his Active Directory IDs (john.doe@**bassnet.no** and john.doe@**bassnet.my**), instead of just "john.doe".

However, assuming there are two users named John Doe with two different domains (one in Norway and one in Malaysia), then they will be differentiated by their User ID:

- John Doe 1:  
User ID: **BASS91919**  
Active Directory ID: john.doe@**bassnet.no**
- John Doe 2:  
User ID: **BASS92920**  
Active Directory ID: john.doe@**bassnet.my**

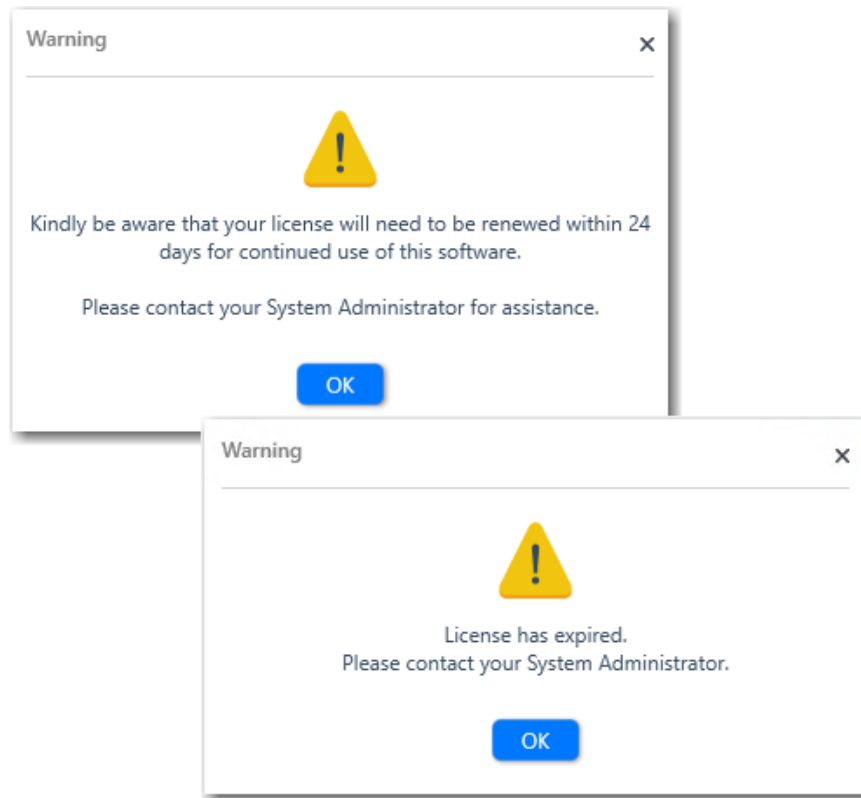
In any case, one user can only have one Active Directory ID (if they have two or more accounts, then their domains in the Active Directory ID cannot be the same). When registering a new user, make sure the domain is included in the **Active Directory ID** field.

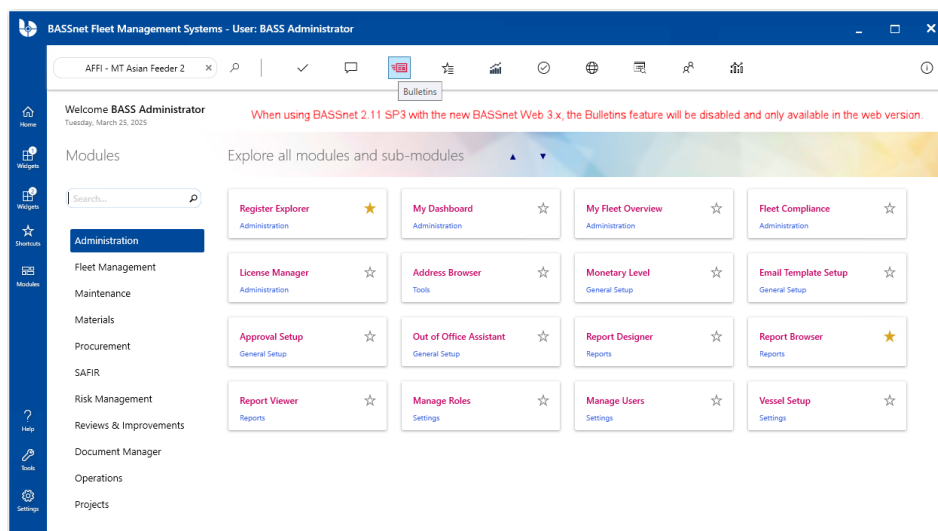
**Note:** This update includes configuration changes that are required for the system to function properly. If these changes are not applied, users may experience issues when accessing the system. A step-by-step guide will be provided to assist with the configuration process. For further clarification or assistance, please contact BASS Support.

- ❑ [CR 16000] The license expiry warning messages on the login screen (before and after license expiration) have been updated to advise users to contact their System Administrator for licensing inquiries and renewal, instead of reaching out to BASS Support. This update ensures that users seek internal assistance first before contacting BASS.



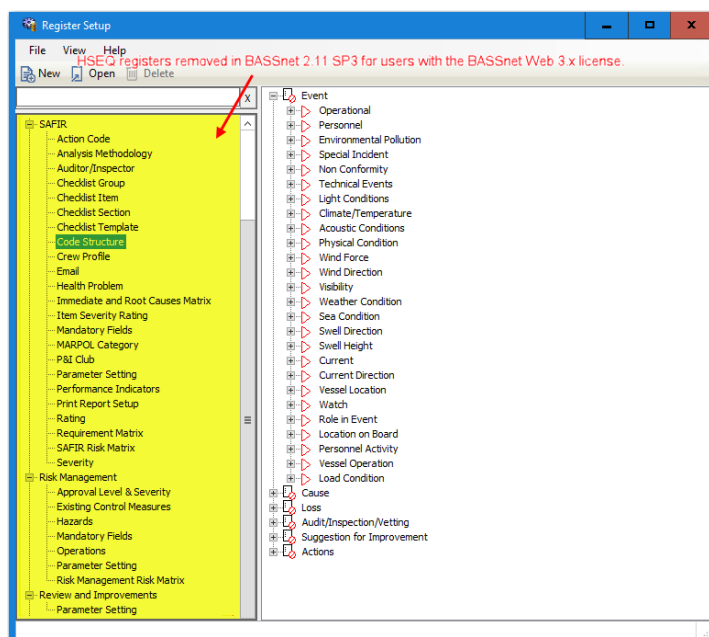
- ❑ [CR 16053] The **Bulletins** feature is now disabled in BASSnet 2.11 SP3 **when used in co-existence with the new BASSnet Web 3.x**. This change is due to database schema updates implemented in the web version.

Moving forward, the Bulletins feature will only be available and supported in BASSnet Web 3.x **when co-existing with BASSnet 2.11 SP3**, and users are advised to access and manage bulletins exclusively through the web platform.



- ❑ [CR 16054] The following HSEQ-related registers have been removed from the **Register Setup** in BASSnet 2.11 SP3 *when used in co-existence with the new BASSnet Web 3.x*:
- **SAFIR**
  - **Risk Management**
  - **Review and Improvements**

Moving forward, these registers will only be available and supported in BASSnet Web 3.x *when co-existing with BASSnet 2.11 SP3*, and users are advised to access and manage these registers exclusively through the web platform.

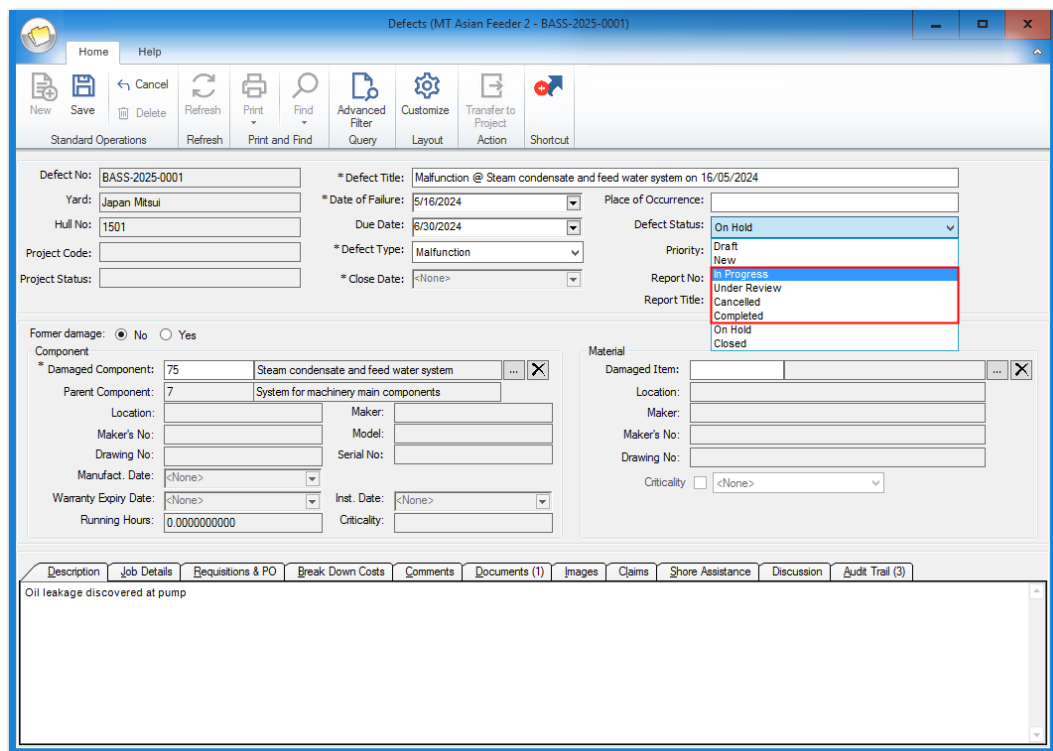


**Note:** Since the SAFIR register has been removed, registers under the **Code Structure** category, such as **Wind Force** and **Sea Condition**, can only be accessed and managed in BASSnet Web 3.x when using the BASSnet 2.11 SP3 **Ship Log** sub-module.


## 2. Maintenance




- ❑ [CR 15787] Users are now allowed to change **On Hold** defects to other statuses. The following controls have been applied in this update to ensure a logical status flow for defect management:

Allowed in the System	Not Allowed in the System
Change <b>On Hold</b> defects to <b>In Progress</b> , <b>Completed</b> , <b>Cancelled</b> , or any user-defined statuses registered in the system.	<b>On Hold</b> defects cannot be changed to <b>Draft</b> , <b>New</b> , or <b>Closed</b> .
Change <b>In Progress</b> and user-defined statuses to <b>On Hold</b> .	<b>Completed</b> or <b>Cancelled</b> defects cannot be changed to <b>On Hold</b> .

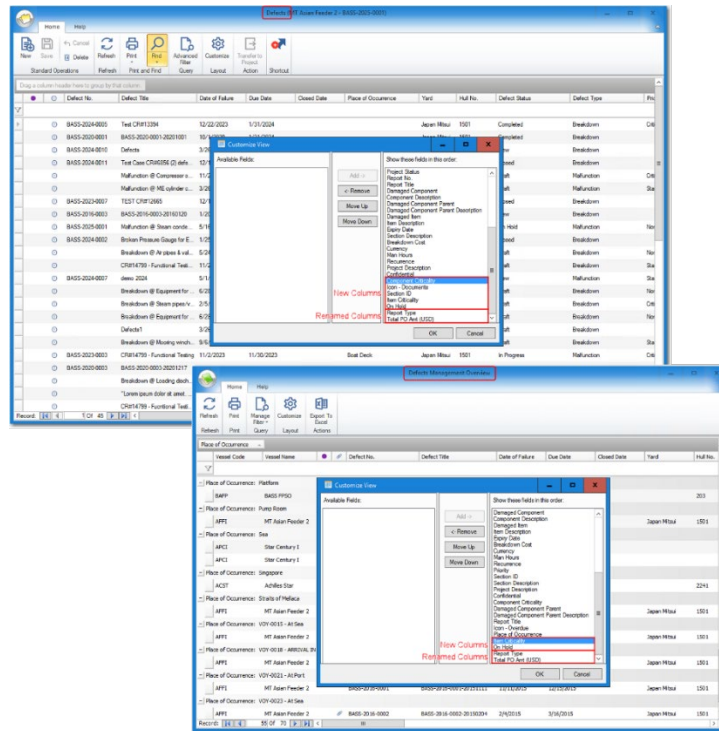

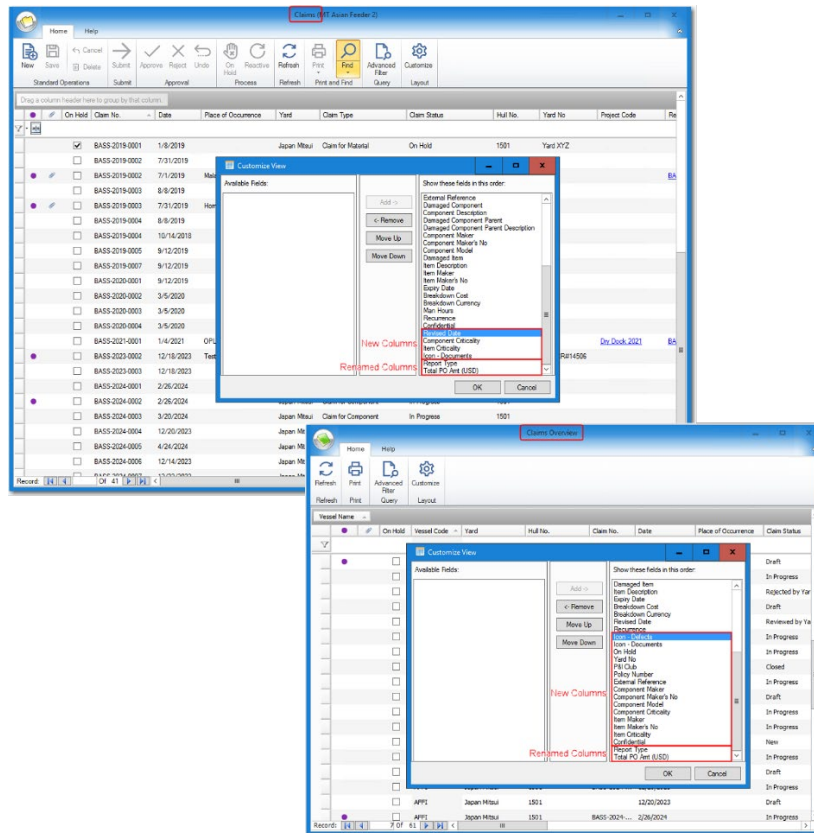
Additionally, the following columns have been renamed in the four sub modules:

- **Total PO Amt (base)** renamed to **Total PO Amt (USD)** – The currency in parenthesis will be based on the vessel's currency.

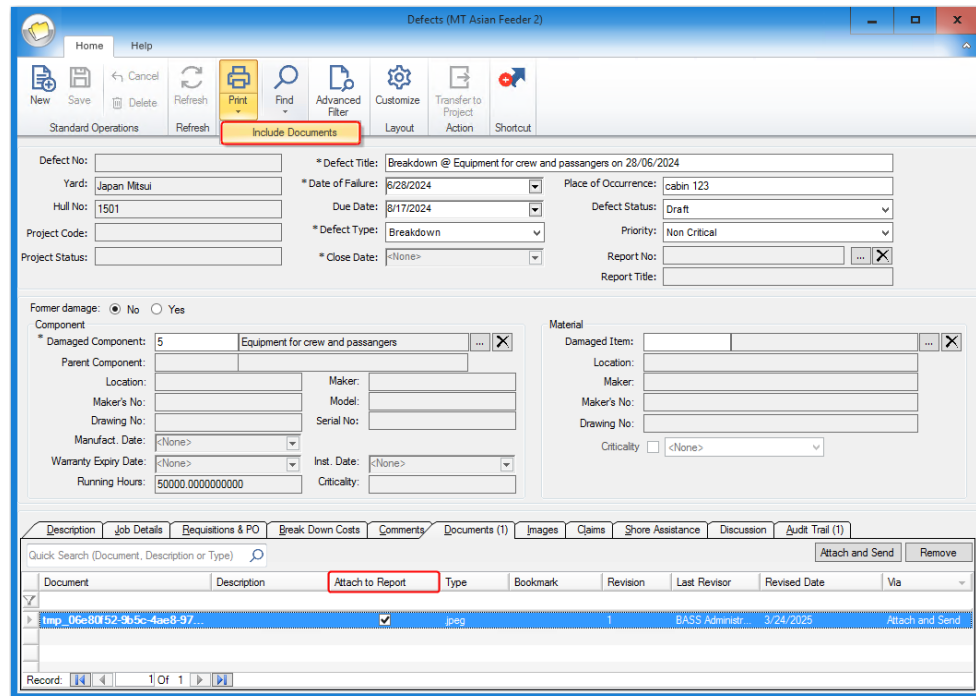

- ❑ [CR 15994] The following updates have been made in the **Defects Management** sub module to support the inclusion of documents in the **Defects Report**:

- Added a new '**Attach to Report**' check box column under the **Documents** tab. Users can select this check box for each attached or connected document to include in the Defects Report.
- Added a new **Include Documents** drop-down option for the **Print** button. When selected, the Defects Report will display the documents that have 'Attach to Report' selected.

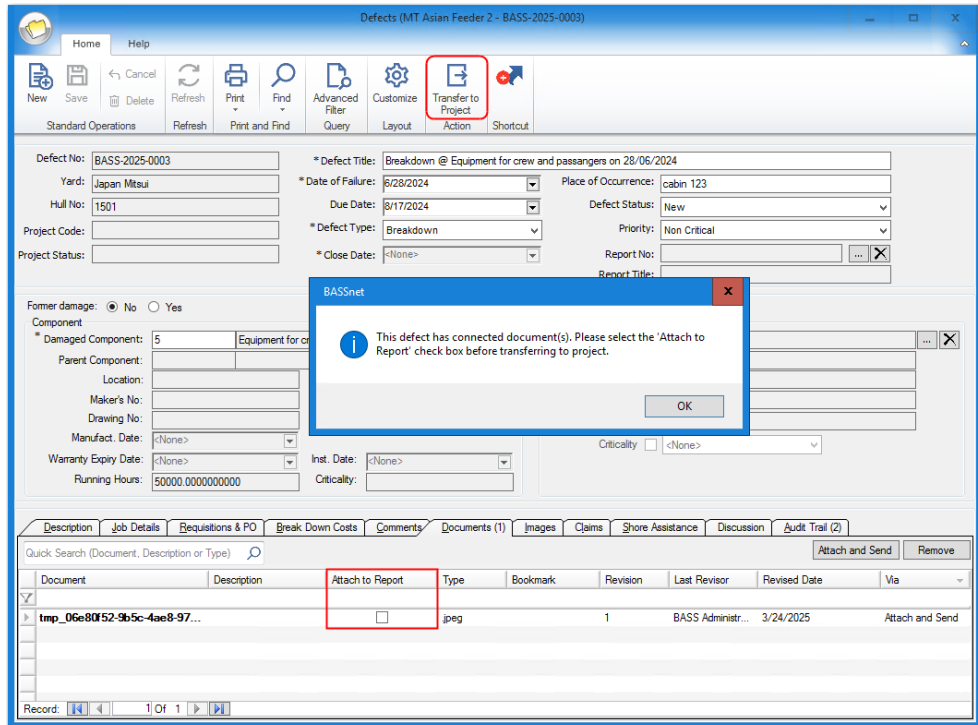

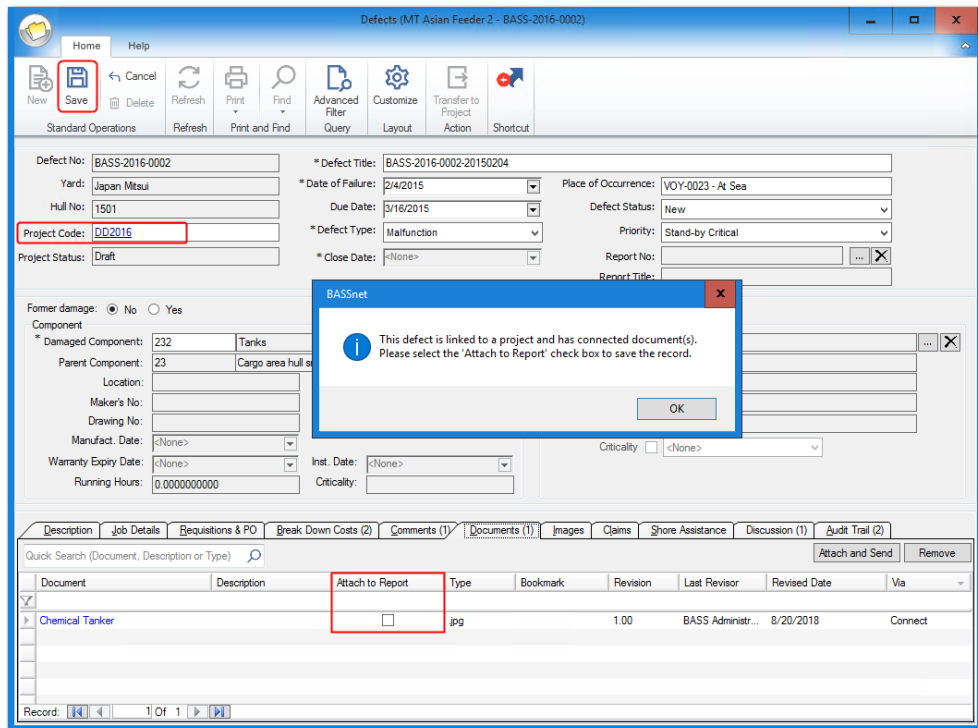

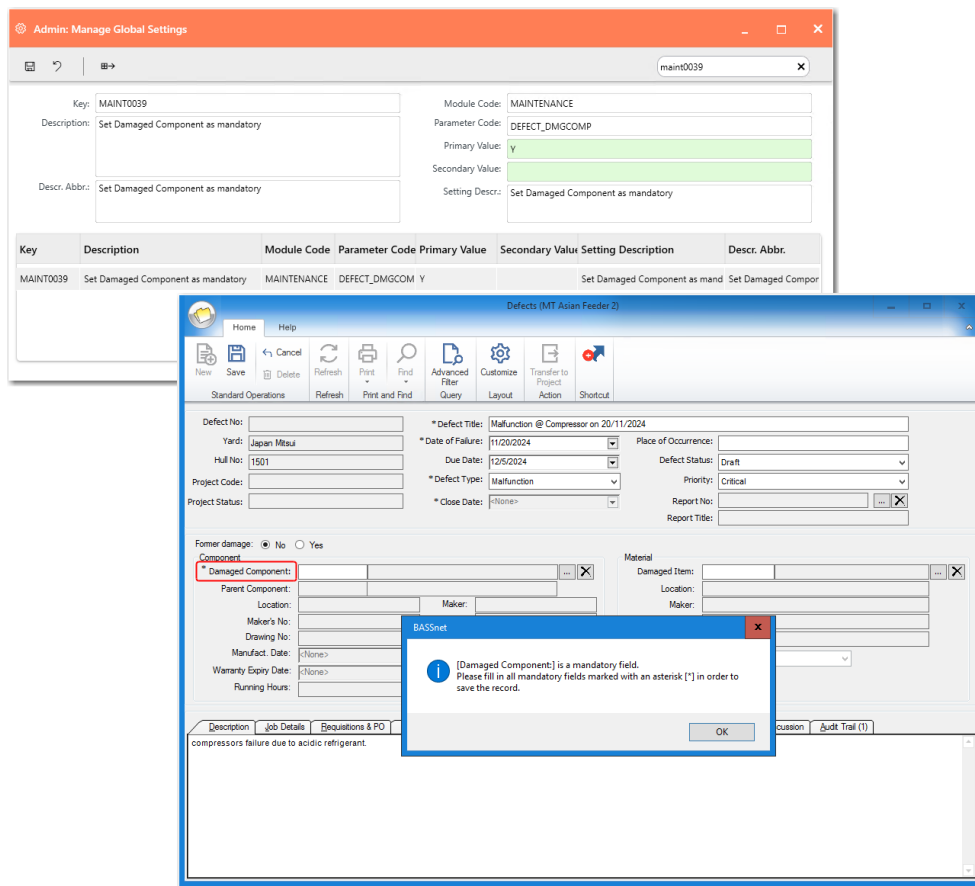

- ❑ [CR 15964] Added the new **Maint0039** configuration key in Global Settings that will allow users to set the **Damaged Component** field on the **Defects** screen as mandatory / non-mandatory.

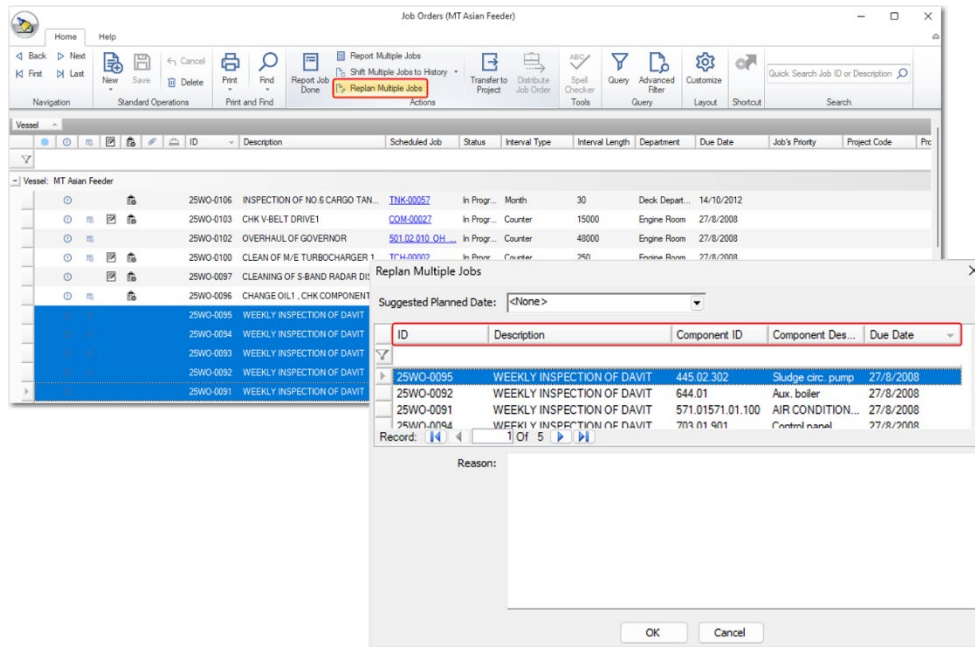

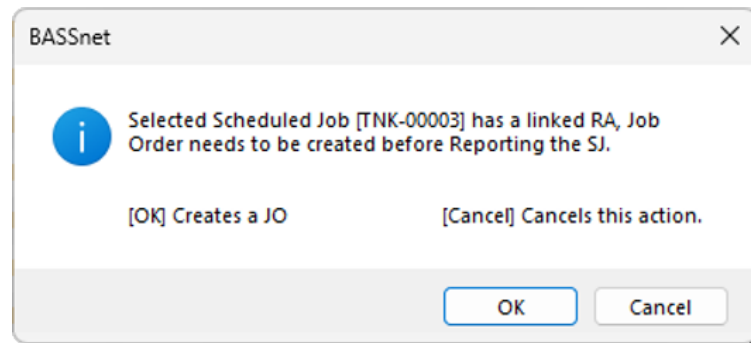

- ❑ [CR 15834] For easier review and management of multiple Jobs during replanning, the **Replan Multiple Jobs** pop-up screen has been enhanced to include the following details:
  - ID
  - Description
  - Component ID
  - Component Description
  - Due Date

Users will also be able to open the Jobs displayed in the pop-up by double-clicking the row.

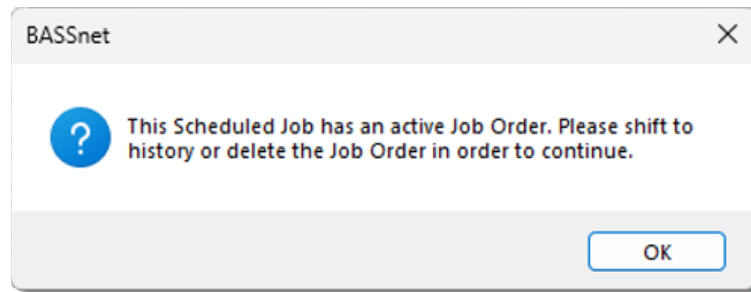


- ❑ [CR 15887] For Scheduled Jobs that have linked Risk Assessments but no active Job Orders, the following validation message will now be displayed when reporting the Scheduled Job as 'Done':



- ❑ [CR 15869] A new validation has been added to prevent the deletion of Scheduled Jobs that are linked to active Job Orders. Previously, Scheduled Jobs that are linked to active Job Orders could be deleted and the Job Orders remained active without any prompt or restriction.

In this update, the system will display the following message when users attempt to delete a Scheduled Job with an active Job Order:

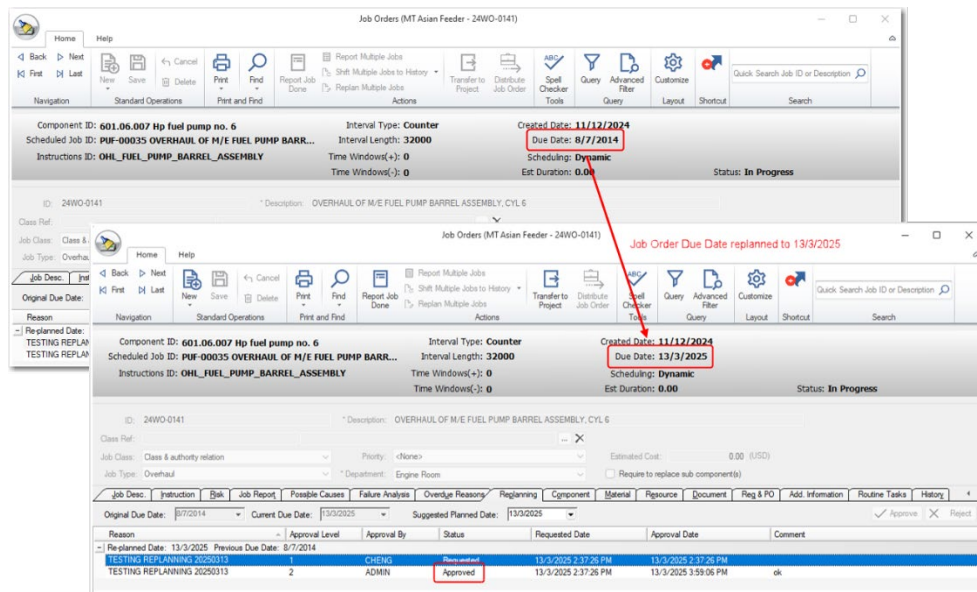


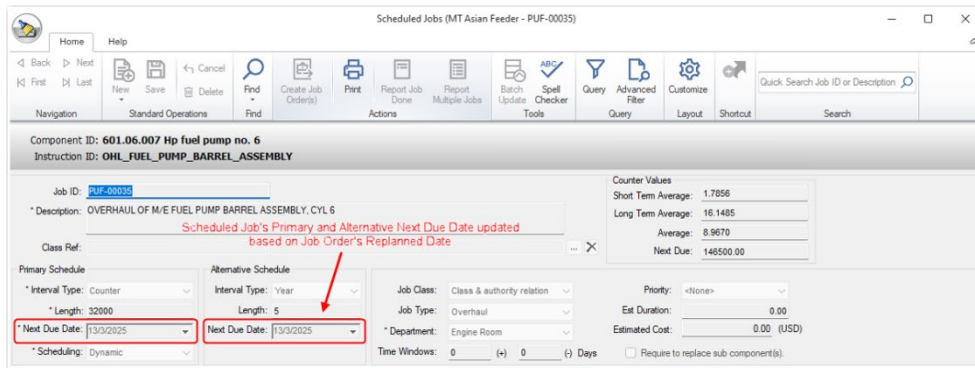
- ❑ [CR 15852] When a Counter-based Job Order linked to a Scheduled Job is replanned, the Scheduled Job's Primary and Alternative Next Due Date will now update to match the replanned date of the Job Order.

Editing is disabled for the **Next Due Date** fields until the Job Order is either shifted to history or deleted. These changes apply when replanning Counter-based jobs from the following screens:

- **Job Order – Replanning tab**
- **Maintenance Planner**
- **My Approvals**

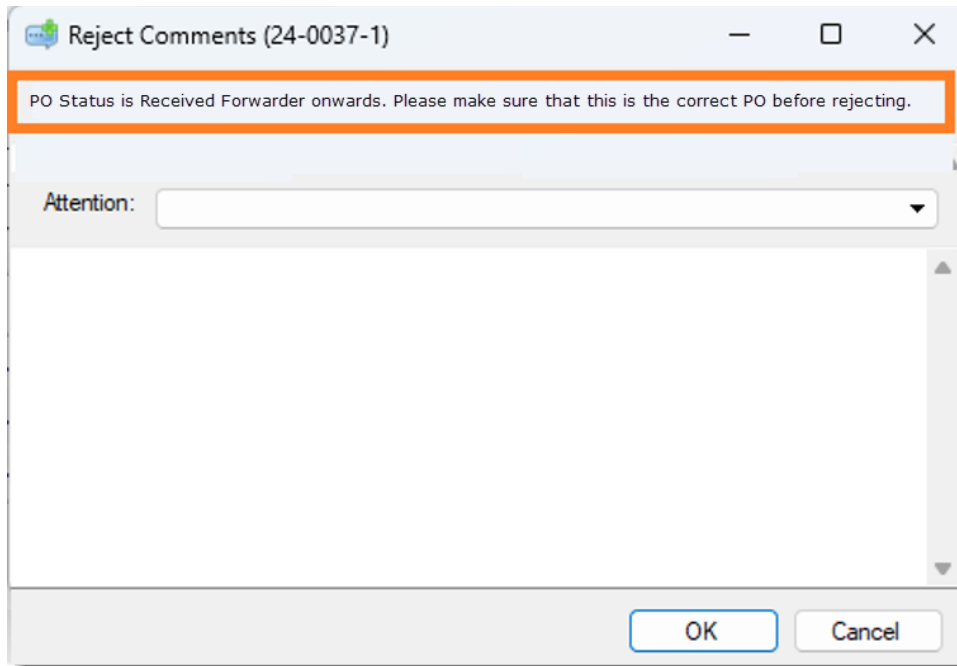
**Note:** If Alternative Next Due Date is not set, the date will show as <None> and will not be updated.





### 3. Procurement

- ❑ [CR 15847] A warning message will now be displayed in the **Reject Comments** pop-up screen when rejecting Purchase Orders with the *Received Forwarder* status onwards (except *Fully Received with Credit Note*).

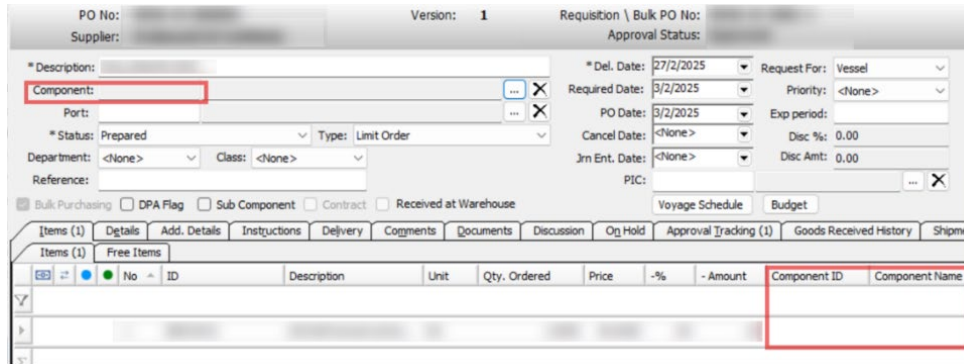


- ❑ [CR 16034] When raising a Purchase Order from a Bulk Requisition, the component ID in the Bulk Requisition header will now be copied over to all the raised Purchase Orders if the combination of Component Type, Component ID and Component Name is available for the vessel of the raised Purchase Order.

If the validation fails for any of the vessels, the system will prompt the message "[Component Type - Component ID - Component Name] is not found for the following



vessels” and the Purchase Order will be raised with an empty Component ID in the header.

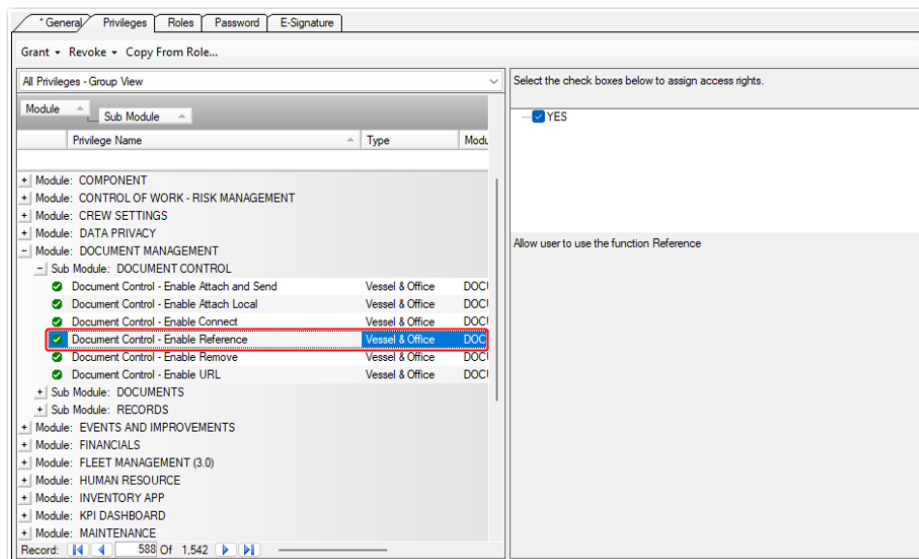
#### 4. Document Manager

- ❑ [CR 16017] The **Record Reference** feature in BASSnet Web has now been added in BASSnet 2.11 SP3 and available only to users with the BNWEB license.

This feature allows users to link records from BASSnet Web modules under the **Documents** tab of any sub module that allows document attachments, making it easy to associate and access related records.

**Note:** This change supports the coexistence of document management in the desktop system and the new web-based system, allowing users to manage referenced records across platforms via linking to improve accessibility.

To allow only certain users / roles to use this feature, the new **Document Control - Enable Reference** access right has been added.

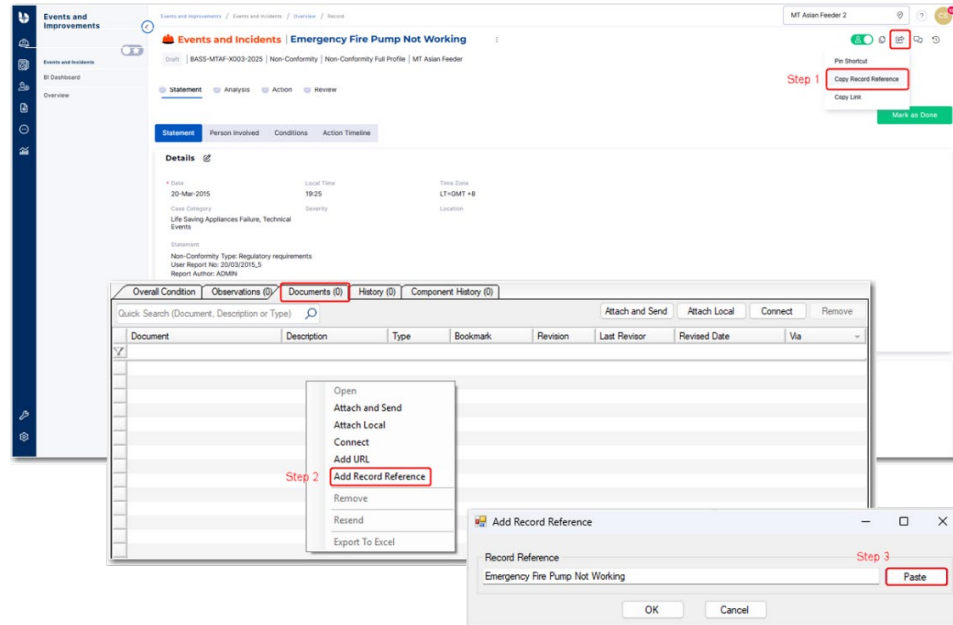

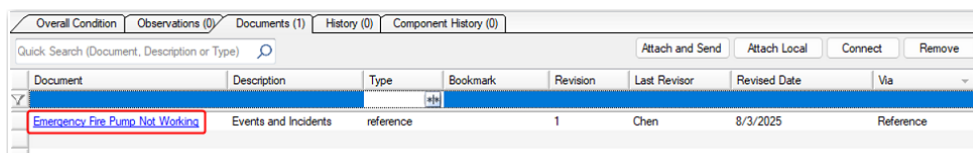

Steps to use the **Record Reference** feature:

1. Navigate to the desired BASSnet Web module and copy the record reference you want to link.
2. Go to the **Documents** tab, right-click within the tab area, and select **Add Record Reference** from the context menu.
3. Paste the copied link into the provided field.

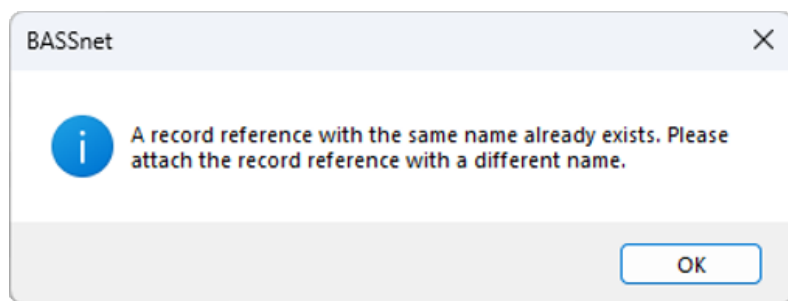


4. Save to complete the process and successfully link the record reference.
5. Double-click the saved reference to open the record in BASSnet Web.



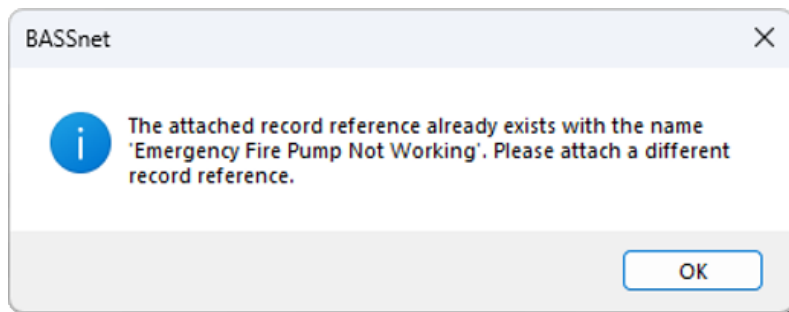

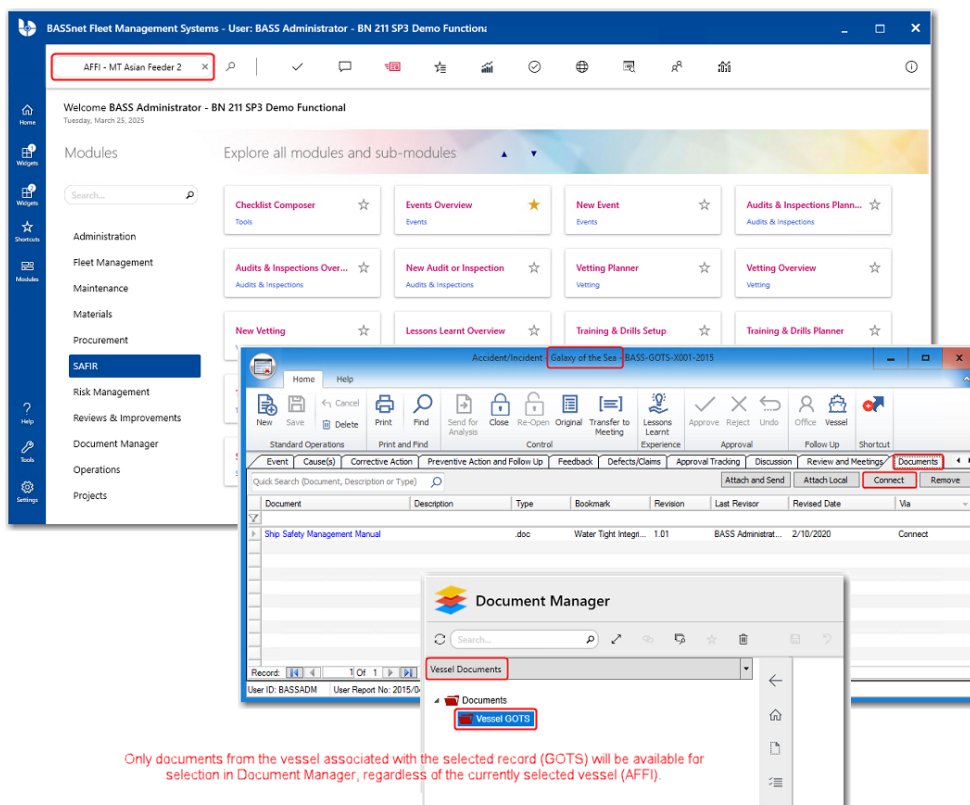

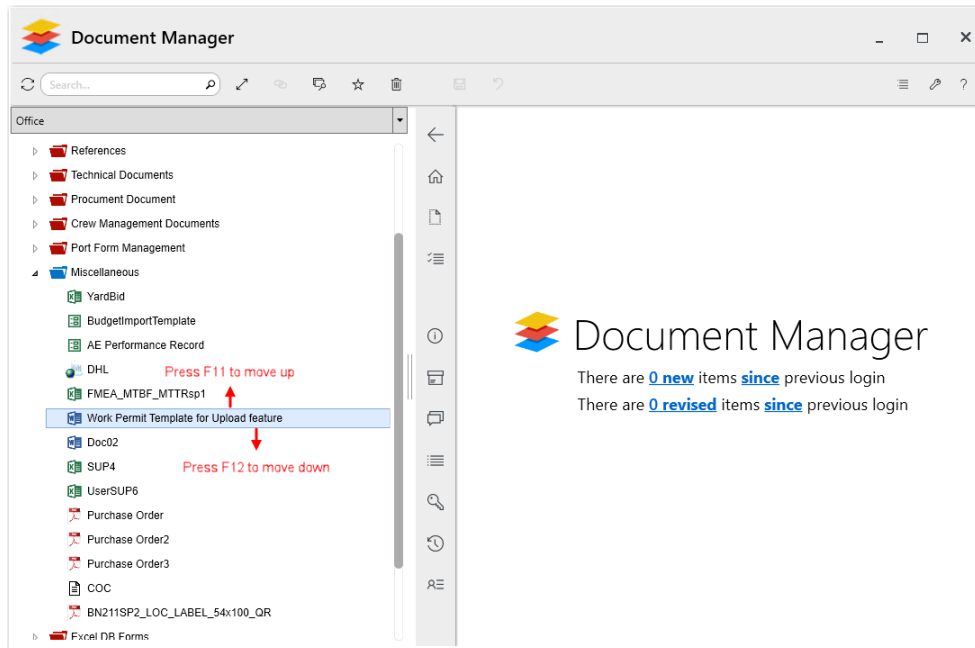
- ❑ [CR 15990] The behavior for connecting documents to vessels has been standardised. Previously, some modules allowed office users to view and connect documents across different vessels.

With this update, documents can now only be connected to records from the same vessel. When a user clicks the **Connect** button, the Document Manager will open and load the vessel tree based on the record's Vessel ID, not the currently selected vessel.

For example, if a user is viewing a record for Vessel GOTS while Vessel AFFI is the currently selected vessel, clicking **Connect** will load documents for Vessel GOTS only. This prevents documents from being mistakenly connected to records across different vessels.

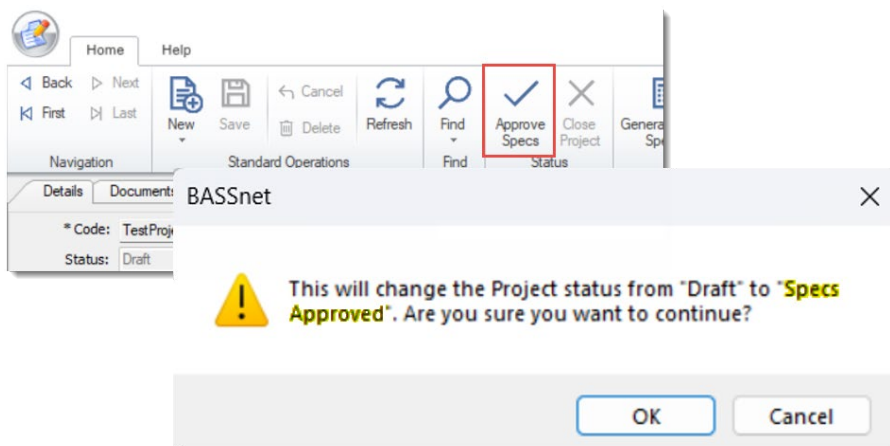


- ❑ [CR 15989] Keyboard shortcuts have been reintroduced in the Document Manager tree structure to ease the sequencing of files and folders. Press F11 to move a selected file or folder up, and F12 to move it down, without relying on the **Move Up** and **Move Down** options in the right-click context menu.

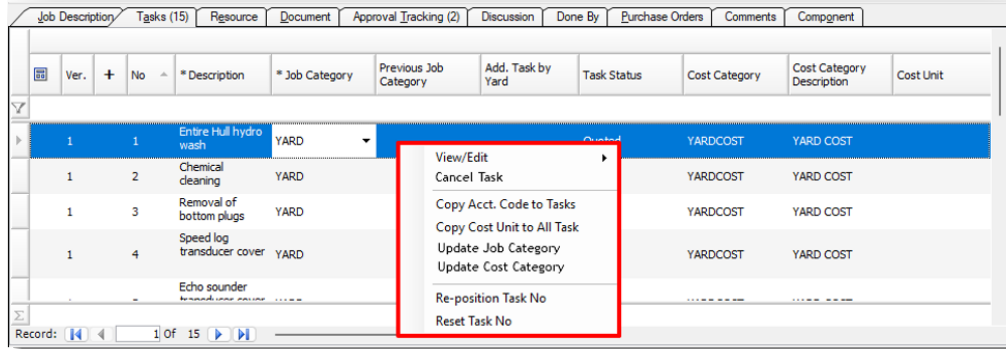


## 5. Projects

- ❑ [CR 15509] On the **Manage Projects** screen, the system will now prompt a confirmation message when the **Approve Specs** button is clicked.
  - If the Project Type is 'Receivable', the status of the project will change to 'Project Approved'.
  - If the Project Type is not 'Receivable', the status of the project will change to 'Specs Approved'.



- ❑ [CR 15944] Two new options are now available in the right-click menu of the **Manage Projects – Job Details** screen – **Tasks** tab. These new options will apply for both Project Jobs and Job Orders. Users can select these options to batch update the job or cost category for all the selected tasks.

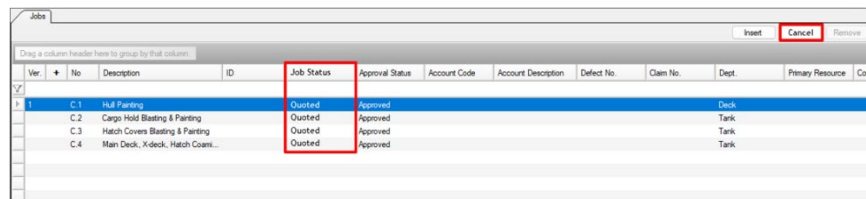

- ❑ [CR 15927] Project Jobs or Tasks can now be cancelled even when the project status is between *Tendered* and *Quoted* (before Budget Approved). Previously this was only allowed for Job Orders linked to Projects.

**Note:** In *Budget Approved* and *Awarded* statuses, the user needs to undo the budget approval and revoke the award, respectively, before cancellation is allowed.

In addition, the following changes have been made to improve the cancellation process:

- A new **Cancel** button has been added to the **Manage Projects** screen to allow cancellation of multiple jobs at the same time. However, Job Orders cancelled using this method will not be reflected inside the Job Order records. Proceed to the Job Orders sub module to cancel the Job Order records.

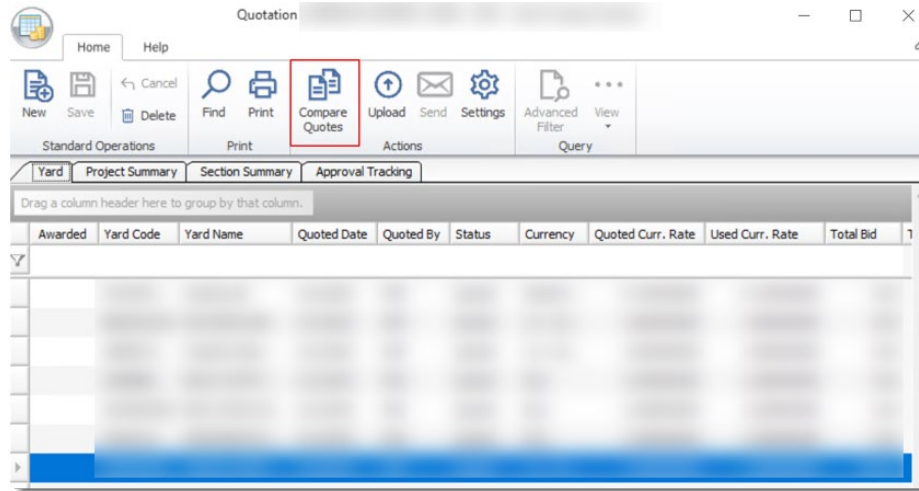
## 5. Projects

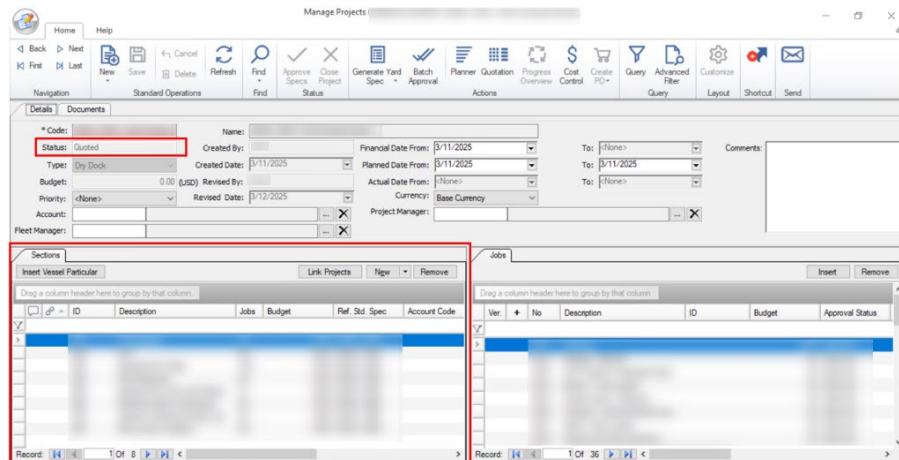
