

Defects

1. Home & Administration

- ❑ [82904] Fixed a data validation error in the **Material & Contract Data** tool that prevented users from adding materials into the system.


This error occurred because columns that were meant to be text-formatted were detected as numerical format, causing the system to remove leading zeros from the data in the Excel template.

2. Maintenance

- ❑ [82472] Resolved an issue where completed Routine Task records continued to display under the **Routine Task** tab for a connected component even after the recurrence period has ended.

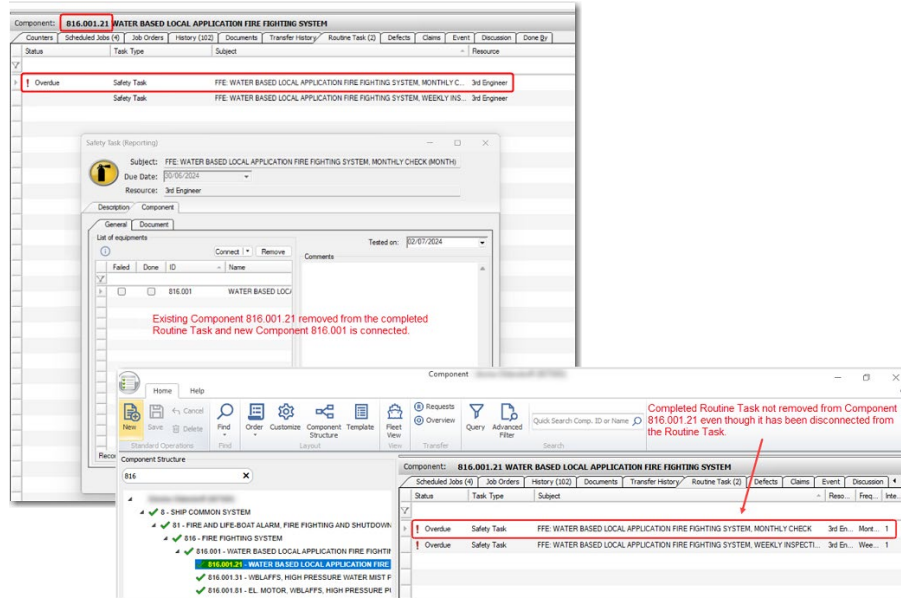

- ❑ [82905] Resolved an issue where completed Routine Task records continued to display under the **Routine Task** tab for a component, even after removing that component from the Routine Task and connecting a new one.



- ❑ [82934] Resolved an issue in the **Material Inventory Report** where the number of records generated was significantly lower than the actual number of materials in the system.

This discrepancy occurred due to an incorrect 'JOIN' clause in the SQL query, which caused materials under a shared distribution group to be excluded from the report when a different vessel is added to the group.

- ❑ [82792] Resolved an issue where the **Event Date** entered in an Accident/Incident report reset to **<None>** when there were personnel added in the Loss tab and the report was saved and sent for analysis.
